The Maryland State Library for the Blind and Print Disabled provides **FREE** reading materials in accessible formats to Marylanders who suffer from Print Impairments. The library provides **FREE** audio, large print, and Braille books, as well as audio and Braille magazines.

### Typical Print Impairments include:

- Macular Degeneration
- Non-operative Cataracts
- Glaucoma
- Diabetic Retinopathy
- Low to No Vision
- Physical Impairments preventing the holding of reading materials
- Organic Impairment that prevents the use of standard reading materials

The library also provides accessible technology training, accessible college textbooks, accessible programs/events and access to community resources.
