We offer eligible seniors a variety of reading materials in a wide range of subjects. Large print, Braille and talking books allow seniors to read the latest bestseller or to keep up with a favorite magazine. Materials are sent and returned by postage-free mail. Participants in the program also may download Braille and audio books through BARD (the Braille and Audio Reading Download service) or through the free BARD Mobile app.
