Washtenaw Library for the Blind and Print Disabled at AADL

All active WLBDP patrons and family members living at the same address qualify for an Ann Arbor District Library card, providing access to:

- Large Print Books: Available in the library or delivered free by mail
- AADL Audio Books
- Talking Book Players
- DVDs with Descriptive Narration
- Books in Braille
- Ebooks/E-audio/E-video
- BARD: Books and magazines available for downloading from the Braille and Audio Reading Download website and mobile app
- Book Clubs To Go: Low-vision Book Club support provided upon request
- The entire AADL collection

An Assistive Technology Lab is located on the 2nd floor of the Downtown Ann Arbor District Library, 343 S Fifth Ave, and is open during regular library hours.

The following equipment is available:

- Kurzweil 1000: Text-to-speech software that works with a scanner
- JAWS: Screen reading software
- A Closed-Circuit Television: Magnifies print in either black and white or color mode
- A Macintosh computer with a large monitor
